156/21 Planning (2021 Planning applications are at Appendix 1)

a) Complaints

20/00717/APP (Complaint Ref COR17469): Linden House, Grendon Road, Edgcott Buckinghamshire HP18 0TN

The Council has now forwarded this complaint to the Ombudsman. The Council has received an acknowledgement, reference Case ID 21010867, and should receive a response within 6 to 8 weeks (mid-December).

b) Applications

21/02851/AOP: Outline Planning Application with all matters reserved except for access, layout and scale for the construction of a new Category C prison (up to 67,000 sqm GEA) within a secure perimeter fence together with access, parking, landscaping and associated engineering works. HM Prison Grendon, Springhill Road, Grendon Underwood HP18 0TL. (Deadline for comment 3 December 2021).

It was noted that this application had been re-issued because of a slight change to the title. It was noted that 'layout' had been removed from 'all matters reserved' and the deadline for comments had been extended to 3 December. A decision is not expected until the New Year.

Council continues to monitor the application and has submitted comments following the issue of the Travel Plan, Heritage and Archeology consultee reports.

It had been noted on Facebook and the PC website that the application deadline for comment had been extended to 3 December.

It was noted that the BBC had reported that the Ministry of Justice is finding it difficult to recruit staff into the prison service and this has been posted onto the planning portal with comments.

157/21 Finance

a) Payment and Receipts

It was provisionally agreed to increase the precept to £10,500. However, a final decision will be made at the January meeting.

159/21 Village Hall

a) Committee update

No updates were available.

- b) Side Fencing/Slabs
 - Chair had spoken to Mark Bone of Aylesbury Vale Housing Trust and the occupant of the house next to the village hall and agreement had been reached regarding the picket fencing. Action: Cllr BK is liaising with J&S Contractors for installation of the fencing and improving the slab step.

160/21 Highways and footways

a) Grendon Road

- RB reported that he is chasing Thames Water to complete repairs of the water leak in Grendon Road.
- The Parish Council is still waiting for the redacted copies of the Cultivation Licenses issued by Buckinghamshire Council to residents.

Action: Clerk to escalate this to CC A Macpherson.

b) Quainton Road

Following a complaint to the Parish Council regarding burst pipes outside a property in Quainton Road, the resident had been referred to Grendon Underwood Parish Council as his property was within the boundary of Grendon Underwood.

c) TTRO

It was noted again that the issue of TTRO's is a shambles. However, it was noted that CC Angela Macpherson is aware of this, and the Parish Council would not be making further complaints at this stage.

d) Pond Corner

It was agreed to ask Jason Barfoot to cut the branch off the tree at Pond Corner to make it safe. Action: Council to make contact.

161/21 Speed watch

a) SIDS (Speed Indicator Devices)

- Chair and RB had attended a meeting with Grendon Underwood Parish Council to discuss the
 possibility of the two villages getting together to purchase two SIDS. Cllr AH offered to attend
 the Grendon Underwood Parish Council meeting on 23rd November to find out more about
 the suggested joint approach and the devices on offer.
- The SID at Pond Cottages will be moved to Grendon Road once EWR receive a permit to allow them to move it.

b) Speed Watch Coordinator

Clerk attended a presentation by the new Thames Valley Police Speed Watch coordinator and reported that a new system is going live on 17 November and would sign-up as the Edgcott Coordinator.

c) 20's Plenty

- Council had responded to a request from Cllr Peter Cooper Liberal Democrat, Opposition spokesman for communities Buckinghamshire Council, Wing Ward to support his efforts to get Buckinghamshire Council to agree to allowing Councils to pursue a 20mph speed limit.
- A recent circular from the 20's Plenty campaign contained a video from Rod King MBE, its founder, supporting the case for a national 20mph limit for the <u>UK</u> which has been uploaded to the Edgcott Facebook page.

162/21 Street Lighting

There were no new updates.

163/21 HS2

RB continues to liaise with HS2's Community Engagement Officer and local parishes. Recent changes to noise mitigation have caused some concern but more details were not available. However, the Parish Council agreed to support surrounding villages once further details were available.

164/21 East West Rail

It was noted that:

- EWR signage had been put up, but it was not clear what it related to.
- C Cllr F Mahon had contacted our MP who in turn would be speaking to the Minister about the recent road closure shambles, especially on Addison Road in Steeple Claydon.

165/21 Oxford to Cambridge Arc

It was noted that 95% of respondents to a recent questionnaire did not want the 'Arc'. No further details were available.

166/21 Community Board
